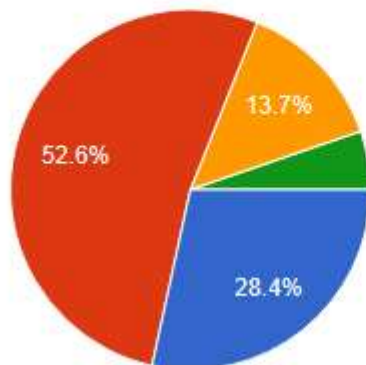


Mowden School Website Survey Analysis

95 responses



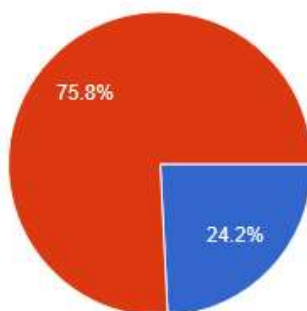
- Within the last week

1c. When we had the recent snow, did you visit the website for information about closure?

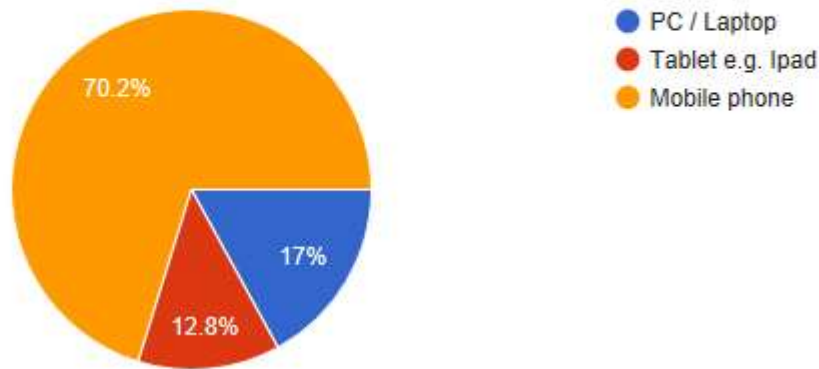

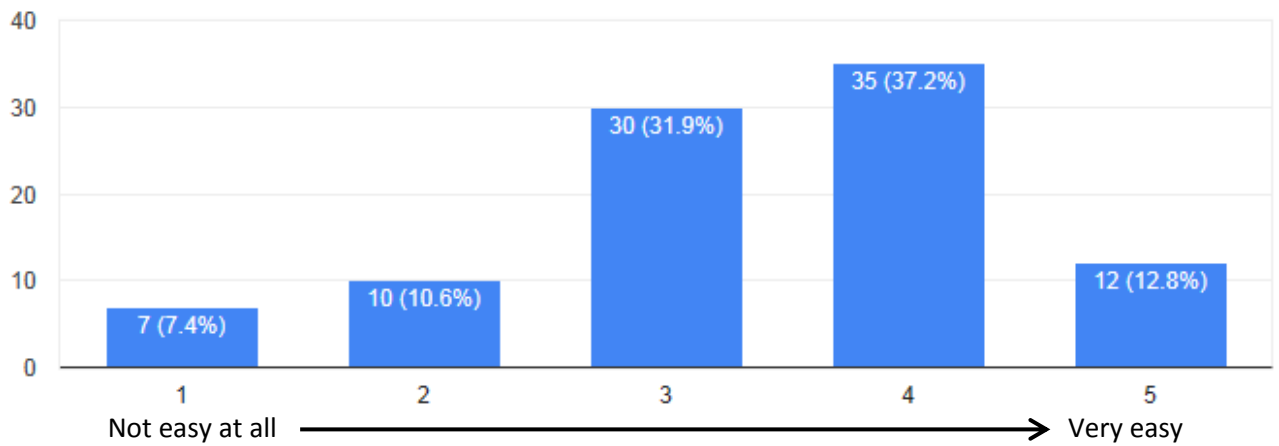
2a. How do you normally access our website?

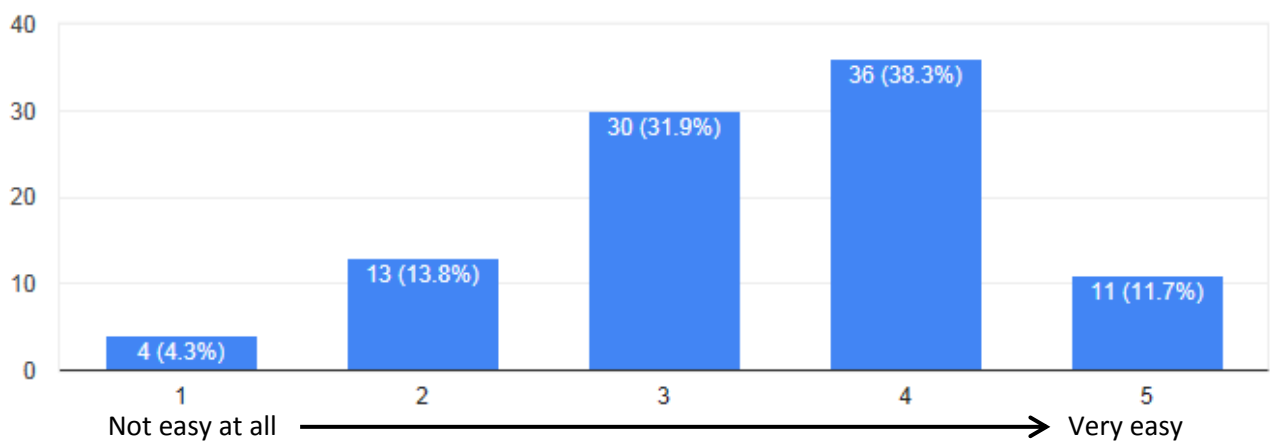
2b. How easy do you find what you need?

Nope

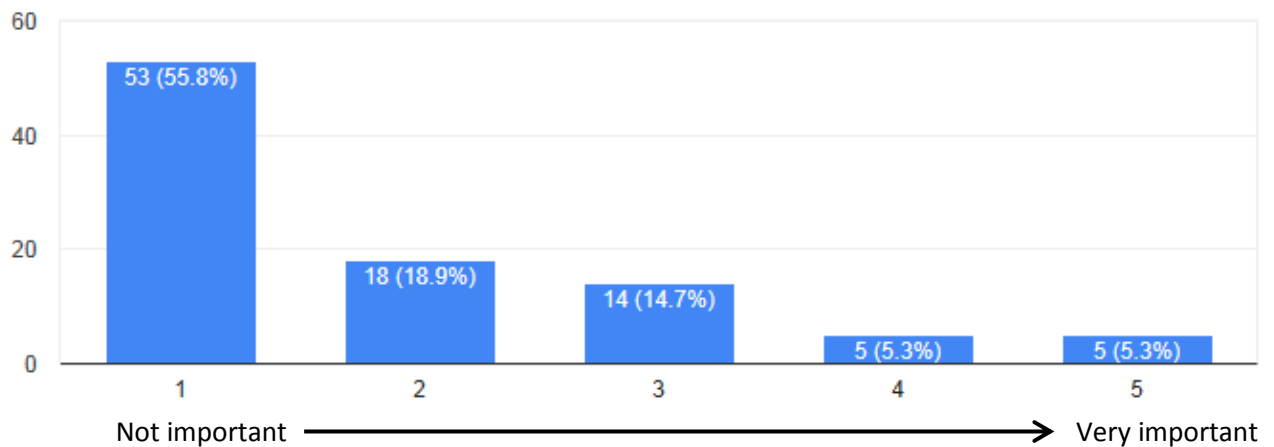
I think the website lets you down

The website lets the school down & should be better

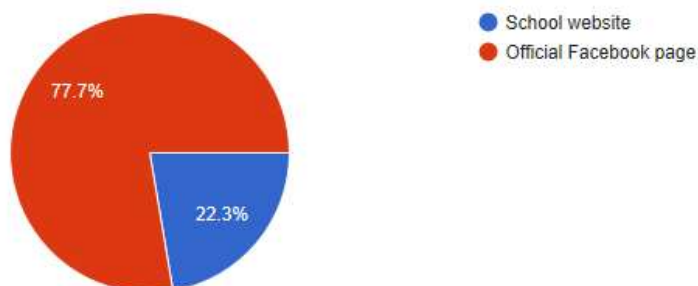
3b. When choosing our school, how important was our website in that decision?

Commentary

By the very fact that we've conducted a survey, parents may have guessed that we are thinking of making some changes and improvements to our school's online presence. These results have been very useful therefore.

Some key points from the results

- The school website is quite well used.
- 70% of parents view it on a mobile phone.
- The mobile version is not very good.
- Some parents (approximately 20%) don't find the website easy to use/navigate but most do.
- Opinion is split. Individual comments show that some parents like our website, whilst others don't so much.
- Visits to the website are mostly to find out specific information, but looking at such as the photos is also popular.
- Facebook would be a more popular way to share information for most parents.
- The website was not that important to parents when choosing our school.

Possible next steps for school

- Improve the mobile version of the website – it is how most parents access the website and through this survey we have discovered it isn't very good.
- Consider how the website could be redesigned, to perhaps be less complicated/text-rich, as well as a little easier to navigate. If 80% of all website visits are for dates, photos, and letters (which this survey has shown) then perhaps these pages need greater prominence.
- Consider having Facebook as an additional online feature.
 - If three quarters of parents would be more likely to use Facebook for school news than the website, then this is something worth exploring. The website could still be in place for all detailed information, with a school Facebook page complementing this perhaps with regular, shorter snapshots of news, dates and events.
 - Aspects of usage (e.g. not allowing replies) and content (e.g. photos, if previously school has said 'please don't share your photos on social media' and now we start doing it) need to be thought out carefully, but this does seem like a good opportunity.
- Separate to this survey, we will soon be bringing a few of our online admin facilities into one app for parents. This will include payments, texts and parents evening bookings.
- Finally, we won't place too much emphasis and energy on all of this. Many parents already like what we have online, and very few chose our school on the basis of the website. In a modern world, this is quite refreshing.
