To support this topic, talk about self-esteem and the role of social media.</p>	<p><b>Science: Animals including Humans</b></p> <p>Key vocabulary to know:</p> <p><b>Fertilisation</b> – joining of an egg and a sperm</p> <p><b>Reproduction</b> - the process by which living things produce offspring</p> <p><b>Gestation</b> – the period of development during the carrying of an embryo</p> <p><b>Puberty</b> – the time during which the human body transforms from that of a child to that of an adult capable of reproduction.</p> <p><b>Life Expectancy</b> – the number of years a person can expect to live</p> <p><b>Pregnancy</b> – the time during one or more offspring develops (gestates) inside a womb</p> 	<p><b>History: Ancient Greece</b></p> <p>Key vocabulary to know:</p> <p><b>Democracy</b> – is a government that is run by the people</p> <p><b>Ancient</b> – very old; existing for many years</p> <p><b>Immortal</b> – living or lasting forever</p> <p><b>Empire</b> – a group of territories or peoples under one ruler</p> <p><b>Civilisation</b> – an advanced stage (as in art, science, and government) in the development of society</p> 
	<p><b>English:</b></p> <p>Read your book at least 3 times a week. Talk about the story, characters, predictions, etc or share some facts from the book. Spellings and English homework are on Spelling Shed.</p>	<p><b>Maths:</b></p> <p>Logon to TT Rockstars – can you move up the leaderboard this term?
